- 3. All the senses are involved. Song of S. 1:3 1:12-13 4:13 7:13a(smell), 1:15-16 (sight), 1:2, 2:3 4:11(taste), 2:14b (hearing), 7:8 8:3(touch)
- 4. It reminds us to guard against those things which threaten marriage. Song of S. 2:15
- 5. It demonstrates the result of selfishness. Song of S. 5:2-8
- 6. Married couples use their words to express their joy with each other. Song of S. 1:9 4:1b-7 5:10-16 6:4-7 7:2-9
- 7. The loving couple is creative. Song of S. 7:11-13
- 8. There are warnings to remain chaste until marriage. Song of S. 2:7 3:5 8:4
